By reaffirmation of the promises made at Baptism and Confirmation, a Daughter pledges herself to a life-long program of prayer, service and evangelism dedicated to the spread of Christ's Kingdom and the strengthening of the spiritual life of her parish.

Our chapter prays for each member of our parish every day. We have prayer boxes for prayer requests in the Narthex of both the Church and the Chapel. We also send a note to each member of the parish telling who is praying for them daily. All prayers and prayer requests are confidential.

We are not allowed to fund raise, and the money we receive from the budget goes toward postage, programs and hosting Quiet Days and studies.
