The Servant Ministry budget for 2017 was \$15,000.00. Of that sum \$15,000 came out of All Saints' 2017 budget. The Servant Ministry Committee's mission is to reach out to persons in need within our parish, community, state, nation and world. As a committee we prayerfully voted to spend the budget as follows:

75.17% was spent with monetary donations to nonprofit organizations in our community: Big Brothers Big Sisters, Broken Lives, CASA, Exchange Club of Tupelo, Good Samaritan Clinic, Gray Center, Healing Horses, Humane Society, NAACP, National Fire & Safety, NCADD, Regional Rehab, Saints' Brew, Sanctuary Hospice, Special Olympics of Tupelo, Shepherd Center, Tree of Life Clinic, United Way of Tupelo, Weekend Food Backpack Program and Women First Resource Center.

24.83% was given to International Outreach, Rector's and Deacon's Discretionary Funds and parishioners needs.

For 2018, Servant Ministry has set out to research and evaluate new and upcoming charities and organizations within our community that are in line with our parish mission. We have set aside funds within the budget to allocate towards these potential charities in hopes to expand our efforts.
