Servant Ministry budget for 2018 was \$15,000.00. Of that sum \$15,000 came out of All Saints' 2018 budget. The Servant Ministry Committee mission is to reach out to persons in need within our parish, community, state, nation and world. As a committee we prayerfully voted to spend the budget as follows:

- 70.66% was spent with monetary donations to nonprofit organizations in our community: Autism Center, Big Brothers Big Sisters, CASA, Faith Haven, Family Resource Center, Tupelo, Good Samaritan Clinic, Healing Horses, Meals on Wheels, National Fire & Safety, NCADD, Regional Rehab, Saints' Brew, Sanctuary Hospice, Special Olympics of Tupelo, Shepherd Center, Talbot House, Tree of Life Clinic, Tupelo Humane Society, United Way of Tupelo, and Weekend Food Backpack Program.
- 29.34% was given to International Outreach, Episcopal Relief and Development, Gray Center, Honduras Medical Mission, other committees within our parish, Rector's and Deacon's Discretionary Funds and parishioners' needs.

For 2019, Servant Ministry has set out to research and evaluate new and upcoming charities and organizations within our community that are in line with our parish mission. We have set aside funds within the budget to allocate toward these potential charities in hopes to expand our efforts.
