Dear friend,

Our annual stewardship campaign is underway! Over the last few weeks, you have been hearing about our theme, "Rooted in Abundance." It reminds us that we are inspired to give because so much has been given to us. Our Creator has blessed us with everything we need to survive and thrive. We acknowledge that every breath and every heartbeat are gifts, not entitlement.

In our times of joy and of sorrow this year, we have known God's gracious abundance: the beauty of the natural world, a baby's first smile; the caring visit; the ministry of presence, and prayers over us or a loved one in times of distress. Through it all, the roots of our faith, and trust in God held and sustained us.

In our narrative 2024 proposed budget, in order to cover our expenses, you will note a deficit of \$53,000. At this point this budget is preliminary and includes a 3% raise for clergy and staff and anticipated expense increases in 2024. The results of our campaign will determine whether we can absorb this deficit or not. In 2023 you'll remember we passed a deficit budget and funded it with accumulated surplus from prior years. This won't be possible in 2024, so in order to fully fund our mission and ministry we'll need to find new pledges, new members and receive increases in existing pledges.
