The choir programs at All Saints' are alive and well and are continuing to grow. There are now 19 members on the roster for the Adult Choir and we average 8-10 each time the Children's Choir meets.

The Adult Choir joined with the Adult Choir of First Presbyterian Church, Oxford to present an Advent Lessons and Carols service on December 10. We then traveled to Oxford on December 17 to present the program there. Both services were well attended, and we all enjoyed the experience of singing with a choir of 40! We hope to have more joint ventures in the future.

The Children's Choir is learning about God's love as we explore John 3:16 each week in song. We will continue with this theme when we resume in late January.
